

PRAYER GUIDELINE

PRAYER FOCUS	PRAYER POINTS AND RELEVANT SCRIPTURES
1. EXALTATION/ THANKSGIVING	1. Thanksgiving (Ps. 65:1,2/ Ps. 63:1-4/ Rev. 5:11-14). 2. Come by the blood of Jesus (Heb. 9:7, 11-14/ 10:19-22). Consecrate your life afresh to God. 3. Ask God for the Spirit of grace and supplication; ask the Holy Spirit (the Great Intercessor) to help you pray according to the will of the Father (Zech. 12:10/ Rom. 8:26).
2. EDIFICATION	Build up your most holy faith (charge yourself) by praying in the Spirit. (Jude 1:20/ 1 Cor. 14:4).
3. PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH LEADERSHIP i. Rev David, Mummy Sarah & the C.E.C. ii. P. Ifeanyi, P. Ngozi and other DC Nsukka Pastors.	1. Ask God to pour upon them the Spirit of wisdom & revelation, sensitivity, and the full knowledge of God's will; that they will receive clear direction concerning what God wants them to do. (Ps. 18:28/ Psalm 36:9/ Eph. 1:17-19/ Col. 1:9-10). 2. Ask for a deeper walk with God (Phil. 3:10). 3. Ask God to give them grace, unction to function (a fresh supply of the Spirit), utterance and boldness (Eph. 3:14-17/ Col. 1:11-12/ Phil.1:19/ Luke 21:15/ Acts 4:29,30). 4. Ask God for the resources needed to fulfil their assignment and sons of consolation to uphold their hands (2 Cor.9:8/ Acts 4:36-37/ Exodus17:9-13). 5. Ask God to shield them from every attack of the enemy directed at them to destabilise their ministries and the people God has placed under them. (Matthew 26:31) 6. Commit their families into God's hands.
4. PRAYER FOR THE LAND	1. Bring repentance on behalf of Nigeria for all the sins and atrocities committed in this land on a daily basis. 2. Pray for the Peace of Nigeria & for her leaders; ask that only God's Counsel for this nation shall stand (Jer. 29:7/ Prov. 19:21/ Ezekiel 9:4-6). 3. Pray for those in authority in Enugu State and Nsukka: Pastors, The Governor, Local Government Chairmen, Vice Chancellors & Rectors, Commissioner of Police, FRSC Boss, Bank Managers, Traditional Rulers, etc (1 Tim. 2:1-2). 4. Ask God to give us the land (Ps. 2:7,8/ Ps. 24:1). 5. Break every negative spiritual influence over Enugu State/ Nsukka and bring the territories under the influence of God (Deut. 2:24,25/ Mark 3:27/ Eph. 1:20-22/ Eph.2:6/ Jer.1:9-10/ Zech.1:18-20). 6. Ask God to open our eyes to the treasures in Nsukka/ Enugu State so that we can give our best while working in this land. For the grace to see opportunities in the midst of challenges (Matt. 13:44/ Eccl. 5:9/ David: 1 Sam.17:25-27). 7. Command the land to bring forth abundantly; let dry land of opportunities appear for the sake of the expansion of God's Kingdom (Gen.1:9-12/ Isa. 1:19/ Eccl. 5:9)
5. PRAYER FOR SOULS	1. Command the strongmen to lose their hold on captive souls; let the veil of ignorance be lifted and the chains of bondage holding the people broken (1 Tim. 2:3-4). - Spiritual Blindness (2 Cor. 4:3,4) - Covering Cast (Isa. 25:7) - Lusts of the Flesh – Addictions and demonic bondage (Eph. 2:1-3). 2. Decree that the Word of God will have free course in their hearts (2 Cor. 4:4). 3. Ask for the conviction of the Holy Spirit to fill the hearts of unbelievers as they hear the gospel and draw them back to God (Acts 2:37). 3. Call forth our sons and daughters into this family. (Isa. 43:5-7) 4. Pray that the hunters and the fishers be released to network the souls (Jer. 16:16). 5. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send forth labourers to gather the harvest (Matt. 9:37-38/ Rom. 10:13-15). 6. Pray for unreached people of the world...places where the gospel has not been heard (starting from Northern Nigeria). Ask God for i. Labourers who have been filled with a divine burden for those places. ii. Doors of opportunity to be open there to enable the gospel have free course. iii. Bind the strong men and spiritual influences of darkness over those places iv. Call forth a harvest of souls from those places
6. PRAYER FOR THE BRETHREN	1. The Spirit of wisdom and revelation, understanding, sensitivity and an awareness of the times and seasons. (Eph. 1:17-19/ Phil. 1:9-11/ Col. 1:9-12) 2. Pray that God will strengthen us in our inner man, give us the grace to function and teach us to persevere in the face of trial (Eph. 3:14-17/ Isa. 29:23-24.) 3. Call forth every resource needed by the brethren to succeed in their God given assignment. (Phil. 4:13/ 2 Cor. 9:8) 4. Pray for the Spirit of excellence to rest upon this family in every area of our lives (Daniel 1:17-20, 5:11-12). 5. Let us be united as one body, one mind and one Spirit and grow in the love of God (Eph. 4:1-6, 29-32/ John 17:11, 20-23) 6. Pray for divine protection for all our brethren and their families. Cover them with the blood of Jesus.

7. DESTINY AND DOMINION	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Let the light of DC Nsukka begin to shine; let the heavens and the elements begin to announce this ministry to Nsukka, Enugu State and the world (Isaiah 60:1-3/ Psalm 19:1-4). 2. Let the highway of the Lord appear for the glory of the Lord to be revealed in our lives. (Isa. 40:3-5) 3. Let the seeds of destiny planted in us begin to germinate; let the fountains break loose and let the rivers of life begin to flow. (John 7:38/ Luke 8:15) 4. Let our light begin to shine and attract the resources and networks we need to fulfil destiny; let our star appear in the heavens. (Matt. 2:2) 5. Ask for the nations and your inheritance; begin to possess your territory and exercise dominion over the sphere to which you have been called (Psalm 2:8/ Rom. 4:13/ 1 Cor. 3:21-23/ Isa 55:5) 6. Prophecy into your destiny (Eph. 2:10/ Rom. 8:28-30/ Phil. 4:13)
8. PRAYER FOR OUR SERVICES AND MEETINGS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask for the glory of God to fill our services and meetings to create an atmosphere of transformation. (2 Chron. 5:11-14/ 2 Cor. 3:18) 2. Pray that God's servant will be anointed to speak a word in due season; words of Spirit and life that will minister to each one and cause a change in their lives. (Luke 21:16/ Isa 50:4/ John 6:63) 3. Pray for a fresh anointing upon everyone who ministers; ask for sensitivity, that no one should minister in the flesh. (Psalm 92:10) 4. Ask God for His word to have free course in every heart. Pray that the grace to put it into practice be released with the words. Come against anything that will hinder the effect of God's word in our lives. (2 Cor. 10:4-5/ 2 Thess. 3:1/ Phil. 2:13)
9. PRAYER FOR PROJECTS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. That God will grant the leaders of the project wisdom to organize and lead the rest of the people to the successful completion of the project (Proverbs 24:3/ Eccl. 10:10). 2. That every single member of this family will catch a burden for the project. Starting from the leadership downwards (Nehemiah 1:2-4) 3. That the spirit of unity will bind us together even as we embark on the implementation of the project (Mark3:24/ Mark 11:6). 4. Call forth resources and opportunities for the project and ask God to give us eyes to see any opportunities through which he has provided the resources that we need for the project. (Phil 4:19/ Haggai 2:8). 5. Ask God for grace and capacity to be able to drive the project to completion; grace for giving, sacrifice, diligence and perseverance (Phil 4:13/ 2 Cor 8:1-3). 6. Bind the hand of the enemy concerning any scheme he has put in place to disrupt the progress of the project (Nehemiah 6:1-2/ Matt 16:18).
10. PRAYER FOR REVIVAL	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Let us humble ourselves and ask God to flood our hearts with light, and search out any hidden sin in us that is contrary to his will being established in our lives (Psalm 139:23-24). Let us repent of those sins and ask Him for forgiveness. 2. Ask that God will purge us by the sanctifying power of His Spirit and release upon us the sanctifying grace to put every form of sin and defilement away from our lives (Malachi 3:2-3/ 2 Timothy 20:21-22). 3. Let us humble ourselves and come in repentance on behalf of the church in Nigeria, acknowledging that we have not been faithful in what God has called us to do (Jer. 7:9-11). 4. Let His Holy Spirit begin to brood over us to trigger conviction in the heart of everyone that has gone astray to cause us to begin to seek his face again and return to our first love (Jeremiah 31:9/ Jeremiah 24:7). 5. Let us ask God for an unusual grace in the area of fasting, intercession and supplication to fall upon the brethren to enable us birth this revival in prayer (Zechariah 12:10/ Isaiah 66:8) 6. Every revival is initiated by the Spirit. Let us ask God for sensitivity for every minister in this season to yield to the instruction and move of the Spirit to let him have his way with us this season (Zechariah 4:6/ Isaiah 30:21) 7. Ask for a tremendous outpouring of the latter rain upon the church (Zechariah 10:1). 8. Ask God that even as we are revived in His presence that our eyes will be turned to focus on His mission and the pursuit of His kingdom agenda on earth (Psalm 139:37/ Matt 6:33). 9. Come against any weapon or scheme the enemy will deploy against us to hinder this revival from coming to pass. Distraction, disunity, spiritual fatigue, prayerlessness etc. (Matthew 16:18/ Luke 10:19)
